Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well and that you have enjoyed a restful and enjoyable summer break. As we approach the start of the new academic year, I would like to share some important information regarding the start of term arrangements and uniform expectations.

Start of Term Arrangements

The new school term will commence on Tuesday 3rd September 2024. Please note the staggered start times for different year groups:

Year 7: 9:30 am - 1:30 pm (9.20am arrival at Park Road/Back Gate)
Year 12: 9:00 am - 11:30 am (8.50am arrival at Montenotte Road Gate)

Years 8, 9, 10, 11, and 13: 1:55 pm – 2:55 pm (1.45pm arrival – gate info below)

Year 8 enter via Park Road Years 9 and 10 enter via the Tennis Courts Year 11 and 13 enter via Montenotte Road

It is essential that students arrive promptly at their designated times and entrances to ensure a smooth start to the term.

Uniform Requirements

All students are expected to be in full school uniform from the first day of term, Tuesday 3rd. We understand that there have been some challenges in obtaining certain uniform items over the summer. If your child is missing any items, please ensure they bring a note explaining the situation, and we will of course be understanding.

As a reminder, here are some key uniform updates:

- The school jumper is compulsory.
- The introduction of a new school jumper with the logo does not replace the current one. Both are acceptable as part of the uniform for the current academic year. In September 2025 only the jumper with the logo will be permitted.
- Blazers are no longer part of the school uniform and must not be worn.
- Trainers are now permitted but must be completely black. This includes any logos, trim, laces, and other details.
