# Students achieve successful outcomes

# The Extended Project Qualification



- An EPQ is an additional qualification, taken alongside A Levels and equivalent to half an A Level
- Our Year 12 students take three A Levels and an EPQ
- An EPQ is an excellent taster of university-style learning as it is effectively an **independent research project**
- An Extended Project might be:
  - a dissertation presenting an argument;
  - an artefact;
  - an investigation
  - a performance.
