




Last academic year, the PSA raised over £20,000 for the school from events, and a further substantial amount thanks to your generous donations

PSA FUNDS

What do our funds go towards?

On top of sponsoring big projects such as site improvements, the PSA contributes towards recurring expenses that enhance pupils' education, such as the annual hardship fund for pupil premium and an enrichment fund. It also pays for the Sixth Form trip to Auschwitz (pictured right), and PHSE sessions such as the Comedy School Anti-Knife Crime programme.

The PSA also regularly approves smaller applications to cover one-off expenses, from relationships with external support service organisations, such as the ADHD Foundation (whose colourful Neurodiversity Umbrellas hang from the ceiling in the school canteen area), to buying walking boots for the Duke of Edinburgh expedition (pictured left).

We also put on staff appreciation teas, allocate funding to transition days for new joiners, contribute to the Years 13 and 11 yearbook and Year 7 Hallowe'en disco, and fund the Model UN, to name but a few of our causes.


