Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that this letter finds you well and that you having an enjoyable weekend. It's been a really positive first week back at school following the half term break. The students have settled back in quickly and the atmosphere in the school is a pleasant and focused one. It has also been a very busy start to the half term already with a thriving Careers Fair on Thursday the key highlight alongside a variety of strong performances in the sports arena from students representing school.

Also, a big thank you to all of you, staff, students and parents/carers who played a part in making the last week of last half term such a successful week. We have three very positive and well-attended Open Mornings with our wonderful year 9 guides showing prospective parents and year 6 children around the school. Positive Noticing Day – Wednesday 13th November

We are excited to announce that this coming Wednesday, 13th November, students will take part in an activity designed to help them recognise and celebrate the positive qualities in one another - *consideration in action*. Each student will write a positive note for a peer, noticing something admirable or encouraging about them.

At the end of the activity, they'll exchange their notes, leaving them with a personal message that acknowledges their strengths. This small but impactful gesture is aimed at boosting self-esteem, promoting kindness, and reinforcing that *everyone matters* at Highgate Wood.

<u>Cygnet Autism Parenting Programme is Starting in January – Plus Other Haringey Events</u>

Barnado's charity are working with Haringey to provide a support programme for parents and carers of children and young people who are 5-18 who are autistic. Parents of autistic children may face the usual positive and difficult challenges of parenting. Attending a Cygnet autism support programme may give parents and carers an opportunity to develop their understanding of autism and consider ways to support their child. It also provides the opportunity to meet other people in a similar position and hear about their experiences in an informal but supportive atmosphere.
